The following amendments to the current Citrus Export Standards are proposed:

1. Absence of buttons

a.There is no consensus to amend the current requirements for Oranges and Mandarins/Soft Citrus; the status quo of 20% remains

(50% Dispensation request from previous seasons + CRI research dispensation)

- 2. Thailand marking requirements
 - a. Note that due to these specific cultivar labelling requirements for Thailand, the Lemons, Grapefruit, Oranges and Mandarins/Soft Citrus carton indication tables have a footnote added to address the cultivar name labelling requirement for Thailand
 - b. All Lemons cultivars must be labelled as Lemons
 - c. All grapefruit cultivars must be labelled as Grapefruit
 - d. The cultivar name must not be specified; all oranges cultivars must be labelled as **Sweet oranges**
 - e. All mandarins cultivars must be labelled as Mandarin oranges
- 3. Cultivar labelling for Oranges

A few minor changes are proposed to the cultivar labelling for Oranges

4. Cultivar labelling for Mandarins/Soft Citrus

Due to the EU Regulation requiring that the cultivar name be specified for Mandarins/Soft Citrus from 1 January 2025, the carton indication options needed to be modified (Cultivar needs to be specified)

- 5. Finger Limes Two new cultivars added to Finger Limes (Faustrime and Pink Ice)
- 6. Mandarin/Soft Citrus over-maturity

A minor modification to Annexure H is proposed to make the wording more clear
