RE: CONSENT AND AGREEMENT TO THE COLLECTION OF A LEVY ON GRAPEFRUIT EXPORTS - 2025

Research carried out by the Grapefruit Focus Group in 2024 indicated that there was large support amongst grapefruit growers for a promotional campaign to increase the demand for Star Ruby Grapefruit.

A voluntary levy of 50 cents per export carton was approved for the 2024 and 2025 seasons. The levy will fund the development and implementation of a marketing strategy by Stardust Global. Stardust Global will implement targeted promotions which aim to increase demand for Star Ruby Grapefruit in the international market.

Levies collected in 2025 will be added to those collected and carried over from 2024 to fund this strategy.

As in 2024, the levy will be collected by the Citrus Growers' Association of Southern Africa (CGA) starting in May 2025 and will be administered as follows:

- The producer / grower will provide CGA with an estimate of the grapefruit cartons (including PP cartons) they intend to export in 2025.
- The CGA will invoice the grower / producer based on the estimate provided.
- The levy will be invoiced and collected monthly over a 5 month period starting in May 2025 and ending in September 2025.

The agreement / consent is as follows:

- To pay a levy of 50 cents per exported 17-kilogram equivalent grapefruit carton, including PP cartons in 2025.
- To the CGA administering and collecting this levy as detailed above.
